HS Dress Code

We expect all students to be clean, modest, and neat. Please be aware of what your student is wearing. The kind/type of clothing a student wears definitely affects attitude, conduct, and work habits. In school, the dress should reflect the fact that the student is working on the job of being educated. Dress should be appropriate for the activity involved. If a student is unsure that an article of clothing is acceptable, please have them ask a teacher or administrator for clarification before wearing it.

Please note that the administration reserves the right to make necessary changes and make judgment calls in the best interest of the JCS student body.

Everyone:

- 1. <u>Pants/Shorts</u>:
 - Jeans/khakis are allowed but may not be too tight
 - Undergarments should not be seen
 - No clothing that is torn, shabby, or with holes
 - No sagging pants/shorts
 - No leggings or spandex unless worn under a skirt or dress shirt
 - No athletic shorts/pants
 - Shorts are permitted but must be modest in length. (approaching the knee, not more than 4" from the top of the knee)
- 2. <u>Sweatshirts/Shirts</u>:
 - Any clothing that advertises inappropriate words or logos, skulls, gang signs, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, camouflage, movies, rock music groups, or anything disrespectful to Christianity, sexual connotations, has occult symbolism, or anything else contrary to the school's goals, beliefs, or mission is not allowed. Clothing with Abercrombie, Hollister, or Victoria's Secret PINK logo is not allowed because of what the company represents or encourages.
 - No logos representing local high schools other than JCS
 - Hoods are not allowed to be worn
- 3. <u>Tattoos</u>:
 - May not display tattoos
 - If a student has a tattoo, it must be covered at all times (This includes when wearing sports uniforms)
- 4. <u>Shoes</u>:
 - No flip-flops, beach sandals, slides, or slippers
- 5. <u>Coats</u>:
 - Students may not wear outside coats in the classroom

Boys:

- 1. <u>Hair</u>:
 - Must maintain natural hair color
 - Must be off the collar and eyebrows
 - Cleanly shaven, no mustaches or beards
 - No extreme hairstyles

2. <u>Piercings</u>:

- No piercings of any kind
- 3. <u>Shirts</u>:
 - Shirts with appropriate words and logos are acceptable
 - Any clothing that advertises inappropriate words or logos, skulls, gang signs, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, camouflaged movies, rock music groups, or anything disrespectful to Christianity, sexual connotations, has occult symbolism, or anything else contrary to the school's goals, beliefs, or mission is not allowed. Clothing with Abercrombie, Hollister, or Victoria's Secret PINK logo is not allowed because of what the company represents or encourages.

Girls:

- 1. <u>Hair</u>:
 - May not color hair bright or unnatural colors
 - Must stay away from extreme hairstyles
- 2. <u>Piercings</u>:
 - No tongue, nose, eyebrow, lip, or body piercings
 - If a student has one of these piercings, it must be removed during school or school events, filled with a clear plug, or otherwise covered.

3. <u>Shirts</u>:

- Shirts with appropriate words and logos are acceptable
- Any clothing that advertises inappropriate words or logos, skulls, gang signs, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, camouflaged movies, rock music groups, or anything disrespectful to Christianity, sexual connotations, has occult symbolism, or anything else contrary to the school's goals, beliefs, or mission is not allowed. Clothing with Abercrombie, Hollister, or Victoria's Secret PINK logo is not allowed because of what the company represents or encourages.
- No low-cut tops. One must be able to bend over without seeing any cleavage
- Must not see any mid-drift. One must be able to raise her hands above her head without seeing the mid-drift
- May not be too tight
- Must not show any undergarments
- Thin shirts must have a camisole underneath it
- 4. <u>Dresses/Skirts</u>:
 - May not be too tight or form-fitting
 - Must be modest in length (approaching the knee, not more than ~ 4" from the top of the knee)
 - Leggings/tights may be worn as a part of the outfit but does not negate the length requirement of the skirt or dress shirt. Cannot be worn with a sweatshirt/tshirt.

Further Dress Requirements and Points of Emphasis:

- Shoes are to be worn at all times. Shoes with laces are to be tied so that shoes fit reasonably.
- PE students are to have a dedicated pair of athletic shoes.
- No underclothing is to be visible at any time.
- Spandex or very tight-fitting garments are not allowed.

- Jeans must be clean and free from holes and fraying.
- Hats may not be worn in school.

Casual Day Friday:

• Students may wear casual clothing on Friday, with at least one JCS spirit wear being visible at all times. I.e., JCS sweat pants with any sweatshirt or JCS t-shirt with sweatpants/shorts. Items must still meet all requirements of modesty.

Minimum dress code requirements for all JCS School sponsored events, i.e., athletic events, concerts, etc. (unless directly specified for an activity): Acceptable:

• Athletic shirts

- Flip flops or slides
- Hats

Not Acceptable:

- Tube tops
- Short shorts
- Low-cut apparel
- No undergarments showing
- Half shirts
- See-through apparel

*Modesty is still a point of emphasis on these days/events

Dress for Success:

We want our students to learn what "present their best" means when it matters most. Our students are expected to dress up for any activity that requires them to look and perform at their best. Such activities include but are not limited to:

- Honor Society
- Athletic events
- Awards chapel
- Sports awards
- Band programs
- And when so designated

Boys:

- Dress pants (No cargo or denim allowed)
- Collared or button-up shirt (tie may be required)
- Belt
- Dress shoes/dress socks

Girls:

- Dress pants (No spandex, leggings or denim allowed)
- Dress or skirt that is approaching the knee
- Dress shirt
- Dress shoes/dress socks
- Clothes should not be too tight
