Jackson Christian School Financial Aid Guidelines and Policies

Non-Discrimination

JCS admits students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, financial aid, athletic and other school-administered programs.

Criteria for Consideration

Financial Aid is based primarily on need.

Applications for Financial Aid are available to families who have completed an enrollment application and interview and have been accepted for enrollment in JCS. Families will not be considered until they are accepted or re-enrolled.

Financial Aid is available for tuition only for grades K-12th. All other fees must be paid by the due dates as stated in the JCS enrollment information.

Applications and Deadlines

All families seeking financial aid must complete the online Financial Aid Application at www.online.factsmgt.com. To ensure confidentiality, **FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment**, a third party, conducts financial need analysis for JCS. The Financial Aid Committee uses the analysis provided by FACTS to determine awards. Families must complete the application and provide the support documentation to **FACTS Grant and Aid** before they will be considered. Facts does charge \$30 to apply. If you have questions or concerns about the application process, you may speak with a FACTS Customer Care Representative at 1-866-315-9262.

The following information is required in order for FACTS to process your application:

- 1. Signed and completed online application.
- 2. Copies of your 2023 tax return including all schedules.
- 3. Copies of your 2023 W-2's for both you and your spouse.
- 4. Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Worker's Compensation, and TANF.

Remember that Financial Aid applications will not be considered until a student is accepted for enrollment or student is re-enrolled for the new school year.

The Final Step

Once all documentation has been sent to FACTS Grant and Aid, each family must complete the **Commitment to Christian Education Form**. Once you have completed this form, place it in a sealed envelope marked "confidential," attention Financial Aid Committee, and mail or deliver it to either school office.

Guidelines

- 1. The decision to award any Financial Aid rests with the JCS Financial Aid Committee and is based on the information you submit to FACTS Grant & Aid and your Commitment to Christian Education questionnaire.
- 2. Families must apply for Financial Aid each school year.
- 3. Financial Aid does not cover the entire cost of tuition.

T.R.I.P.

Did you know that you could earn hundreds of dollars towards your tuition? All JCS families are encouraged to participate in the Tuition Reduction Incentive Program. Families who consistently use TRIP have reduced their tuition bill from \$200 -\$2,000 per year, depending on personal effort. TRIP enrollment packets can be obtained from either school office. Every family is urged to participate.

Small Group Meetings

Host a small group school meeting in your home. JCS parents have always been the best source of information and encouragement to families who are considering Christian education for their children. - We will also give you a \$500 credit referral per student
